# GG has many attachment tables

- Inventory ( & Accession via Inventory)
- Order Request
- Accession Inventory Group
- Crop / Crop Trait / Crop Trait Code
- Method
- Taxonomy ... Family / Genus / Species

- CT 1.21.10.4 (not released)  
*Attachment Wizard*

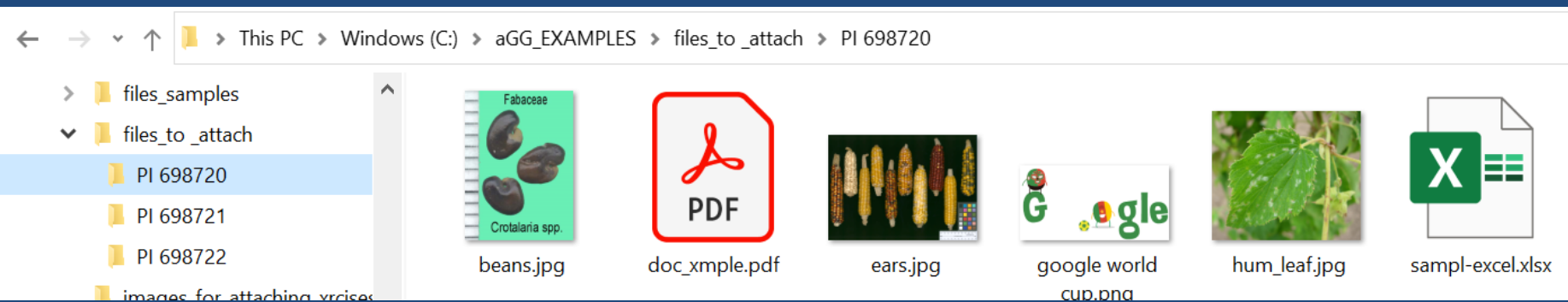
# What types of files?

# Names are Important

- File & Folder names will be “understood” by the CT and Wizard
- if a name in an image file’s parent folder can’t be found, it will look at the parent folder, etc.





# Names...

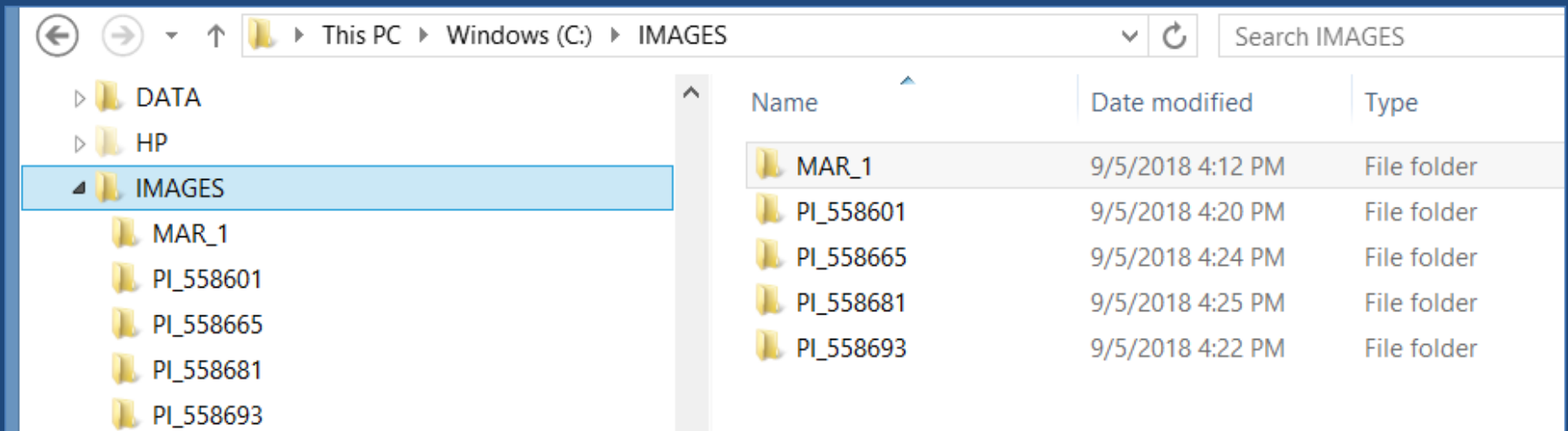
- the following name is indicating the inventory PI 500000 TR05az SD, January 1, 2005, image number 1, and panicle

`\pi_500000_tr05az_SD_01-01-2005_01_panicle.jpg`

Run this SQL Query in the Public Website (Tools option)

```
SELECT  cv.code_value_id,  cv.group_name as group_name,  
        cv.value,  cvl.title, cvl.description  
FROM    code_value cv  
        LEFT JOIN code_value_lang cvl ON cv.code_value_id =  
cvl.code_value_id  
        AND cvl.sys_lang_id = 1  
WHERE   cv.group_name = 'attach_description_code'  
ORDER BY  group_name,  cv.value
```

# Attach Category

- Change previous SQL

- 

From: WHERE cv.group\_name  
= 'attach\_description\_code'

- To:

WHERE ...

= 'attach\_category'

# Attach Date

**Attach Date** field. The valid format is

"mm-dd-yyyy"
