System Inventory

- Necessary for GG
- Not real inventory
- Do not touch!

Planning for Inventory Records

Consider

- which site will "own" the inventory
- how you will name the generations
- where the inventory will be stored
- what amounts are considered adequate / "critical"
- is seasonal availability a concern

Inventory Maintenance Policy

 Every inventory record is tied to an Inventory Maintenance Policy (IMP)

The IMP acts as a template when making new inventory records

The IMP determines ownership

Inventory Maintenance Policy

acts as a template when making new inventory records...

Indicates:

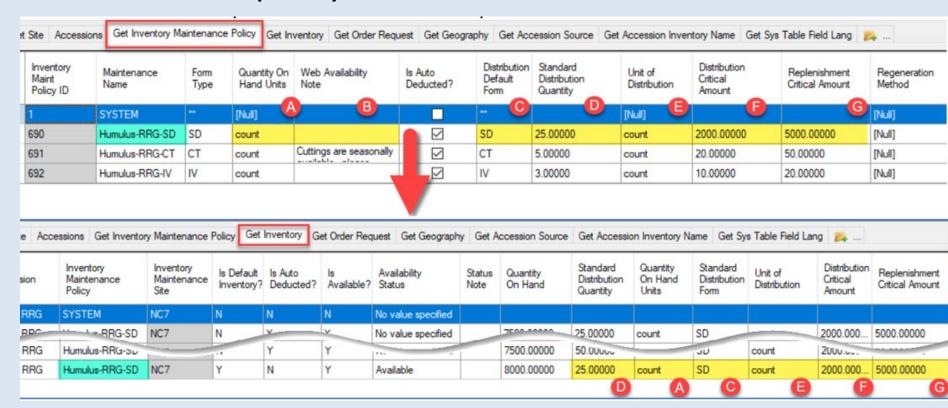
- the germplasm form to be distributed
- standard amount to be distributed
- critical distribution and replenishment levels

Inventory Maintenance Policy

determines the owner

• the owner determines the site

The Inv. Maintenance Policy populates a new inventory record with the policy's default values for *certain* fields
